

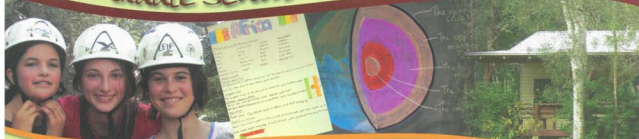

The Middle School

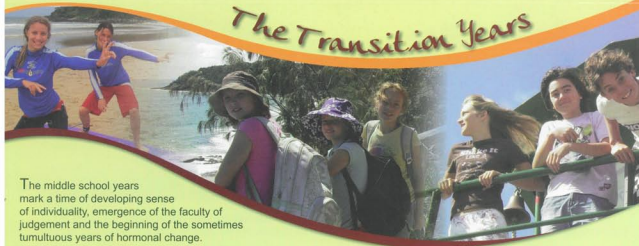
