



## Entry Terms and Conditions

### How to enter

- 1. Registration forms** are available on our website [www.chrysalis.nsw.edu.au](http://www.chrysalis.nsw.edu.au) or simply, email us at [chrysalis\\_t2t@bigpond.com](mailto:chrysalis_t2t@bigpond.com) and we will forward or phone the school on 6655 8616 and we will fax them to you.
- 2. Registration forms** - indicating your intention to enter an outfit and payment must be received by Chrysalis School **prior to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2009**. Postal address is indicated below.
- 3. Entry forms** need to be submitted with your outfit and can be obtained as above. Outfit/s with **entry forms** should arrive **by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2009**. Please note that there is one outfit per entry form

### Outfit Submission and Return

Submissions must be original, must be the work of the submitting applicant/s, and cannot infringe on any copyright, other intellectual property right, or the rights of privacy or publicity or any other right(s) of any third party. Any application, which in the coordinator's sole judgment, contains content which is not suitable for publication or display, is noncompliant, or is in any other respect inappropriate or improper (in the sole discretion of the Coordinator) will not be considered.

The above dates for acceptance of delivered outfits is final - Packaging and transportation costs of entries are the responsibility of the entrant. - All outfits must have a return address clearly marked and if applicable a return courier/postage fee must accompany your entry.

**IMPORTANT:** Submitted Outfits must be hung on a **strong wooden hanger** (NOT wire) and be contained in a **strong see-through, full length, plastic bag**. I.e.: suit bag - **Photographs** front and back view and instructions on how the outfit is to be worn and how to put it on **must be included**. All accessories must be secured in **clear resealable plastic bags** and **labelled** with entry name & outfit name - An itemised list of the total number of pieces. Number each piece and label with entry name and outfit name.

- Please note that sending your garment does not necessarily mean it will be selected for the Chrysalis School *trash2treasure*; selection is at the discretion of the coordinator.

- If your outfit is unsuitable you will be contacted by phone or email and advised when to collect your piece.

- Dates and times for collection of parade outfits will be advised to all registered entrants.

- Works not collected by 30th June 2009 will become the property of Chrysalis School.

- Chrysalis School is responsible for the way it chooses to display your entry, i.e. the choice of model, music, dance and context is at the discretion of the coordinators.

- Chrysalis School retains the right to take photographs of garments and to publish these, with acknowledgement, in publications that relate to Chrysalis School's *trash2treasure*.

-Chrysalis School reserves the right to all film, broadcasting, Internet and any related rights which it may, at its discretion, elect to use for publicity or any other purpose.

## **Collaborations**

Collaborations will be allowed. In the event of collaboration, each artist must sign the Entry Form or in the case of a school forwarding collaborative piece, then the submitting school and class year should be forwarded with the teacher's signature. Fees and Prizes will be paid and awarded as applicable to each piece, applicable to the number of people in the collaboration.

## **Outfit Construction**

Your outfit must be made from either;

- Household, Industrial, Manufactured or Man-Made Waste
- Re-used, Recycled Clothing, Objects and Fabric Off-Cuts
- Organic Waste, leaves, twigs, shells etc

You should avoid using staples & Sticky tape, AND there must be **NO sharp edges** such as mirrors, glass, or chicken wire etc anywhere on the garment. You are encouraged to use environmentally friendly glues, dyes, paints, resins etc in the construction of your garment.

Outfits must be well made, safe and durable, and able to be worn several times for rehearsals, judging and performances. Please consider the weight and comfort of the outfit, as the models need to move freely on stage.

Entrants in youth categories should take a leading part in the conceptual design & construction of their garments. Entries that are clearly made by adults will be disqualified. Primary school entrants have the opportunity to wear their outfit on the parade night; this will involve a dress rehearsal of which you will be advised.

In all other categories, models for the parade nights will be selected by the coordinator from Chrysalis School. Their sizes range from 8 – 14, male and female. Adult models will be selected from the Chrysalis School community.

Label your entry clearly using the entry form. You are encouraged to include notes on inspiration, or stories for the design and recommendations as to how the garment should be worn, along with a brief biography. **2 x photographs must accompany your garment: showing a front and back view. This is essential for judging purposes.**

#### **Checklist**

- Entry Form.
- 2 photographs - please label each photograph with the title of piece.
- Outfit and all accessories are labelled and bagged as described above
- Return postage and or courier fee (if applicable)
- Entry Fee: per outfit

  - Tertiary \$20

#### **Selection Process and Judging**

Pieces will be selected for the 2009 Chrysalis School *trash2treasure Parade* by the coordinator. Judges are selected by the Chrysalis School *trash2treasure* Coordinator.

#### **Entries will be judged using the following criteria;**

- Category adherence
- Visual impact – Choice of colours and overall look of the garment when worn.
- Use of “Trash” – Is the entry made from genuinely recycled or reused products?
- Relevant and innovative use of recycled materials,
- Originality of design.
- Workmanship

The prizes will be awarded on Sunday 28th June 2009.

## **Categories**

### **The Enchanted Wood - Early Primary (K, 1, 2, 3)**

Down In the enchanted woods creatures and plants come to life spreading their magic beyond the woods.

### **Dream Job - Upper Primary (4, 5, 6)**

One day you will have to find yourself a job..... What would you really love to do? Either real or make believe, let your costume show us your dream job.

### **Heroes & Villains - Lower Secondary (7, 8, 9)**

Goodies or Baddies. Real or fantasy. Past, present or future. They all belong In this category. Become a character that fuels your deepest aspirations or fears.

### **Survivors - Upper Secondary (10, 11, 12)**

A celebration of those who, through sheer grit, courage, fortitude or luck, overcame threatening conditions to live another day.

### **East meets West – Open section (over 18 years)**

The fusion of East & West has brought us many inspired characters from Mongolian warlords to Fashion designers to Celebrity Chefs & 2008 Olympics where the East truly met the West. Bring us your cleverest interpretation of East meets West.
